Fairy Tales - Day 2



Today in preschool we are going to learn the story of "Goldilocks and the Three Bears." Just like most fairy tales, it has a pattern of three. Can you notice all the sets of 3 that are mentioned in the story?

Cook



In the story, Goldilocks eats the bears' porridge. Oatmeal is a type of porridge. Do you like to eat oatmeal? Ask your grown up if you can help make oatmeal to eat for a snack.

Retell



Gather 3 teddy bears from your house. Do you also have a doll that could be Goldilocks? Use them to retell the story. Use different voices for big Papa Bear, medium Mama Bear, and little Baby Bear.

Search



Bear, baby, and bed all start with the letter **B**. Look around your house to see how many things you can find that also start with the letter **B**.

The bears went for a walk while their porridge cooled off. Go outside with your grown up and get some fresh air too. Sunshine and fresh air are good for our bodies and our brains.

Fairy Tales - Day 3



Today in preschool we will learn the story of the "Three Billy Goats Gruff." The goats try to cross the bridge, but a mean troll won't let them! Most fairy tales have a "bad guy" in them. This character is called the antagonist. Can you say that? It's a big, smart word!

Build



Use blocks to build a bridge, just like the one that the troll lives under. Make 3 Billy Goat stick puppets and make them go trip-trap across the bridge. Say, "Trip-Trap-Trip-Trap"!

The London Bridge is a famous bridge in England. Do you think a troll lives under it?! Can you sing "London Bridge" and act it out?


Pretend




Fairy Tales - Day 4
