

# VIRTUAL ORCHESTRA RECORDING DIRECTIONS

Please read all of these directions carefully to make sure you know exactly how to make your video! If you have any questions at all, please don't hesitate to ask!

## MATERIALS

1. You will need TWO DEVICES, one to record yourself, and one to listen to the backing track with. Please be sure to record in a portrait orientation (vertical).
2. Please wear something festive for your video.
3. Please make sure you are in a quiet, well lit room and that you are in view on the camera (and not the ceiling). Also, take note of your background, try to represent yourself well with a neat, non-distracting background.

## BEFORE YOU START

1. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR INSTRUMENT IS TUNE BEFORE YOU RECORD!
2. Do a test take....film for a few seconds, then look at it to make sure it looks good!

## HOW TO RECORD

1. You will find the mp3 backing track attached to the assignment.
2. When listening to the backing track, first there will be 3 sets of claps. I will count you off. Please clap along, clearly and on beat. This helps me to get all the parts lined up together. Then you will hear a metronome click. I will give you 2 measures. First, just the click, then I will count off two measures to count you in.
3. Listen to the backing track with ear buds or headphones. (It works best to only have one ear in so you can hear yourself as well.)
4. Record yourself on a separate device from the one you are listening with. Please record in a portrait orientation (vertical). Please make sure you are in a quiet, well lit room and that you are in view on the camera (and not the ceiling).
